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SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

For the week of July 26, 2026

OPENING DISCUSSION | Let's Get the Discussion Started

1) Has anyone here done anything that would be considered heroic? If so, would you share the story?

BIBLICAL REFLECTION | What Does God Say About This?

2) Read Mark 5:21-43, -Due to the Levitical Law, this woman's bleeding would have made her unclean, which would have caused her to be an outcast for 12 years! Exiled from her family, the temple, and society. But read Mark 5:34 again. Jesus calls the woman "Daughter." Why is that significant?

3) In Mark 5:36, Jesus tells Jairus, "Do not fear, only believe." What do you think believing looked like for Jairus in that moment?

4) In this passage, we see 2 people who were separated from Jesus, from society, from the purpose that their lives were meant for. Jesus sought after them and restored them. Who is that in your life? Who in your sphere of influence needs to be rescued from a meaningless life away from Christ?

PRACTICAL APPLICATION | Walking It Out

5) Through the power of the Holy Spirit, step out in courage this week to pursue that person. Take them for coffee, invite them for dinner, ask if you can to pray for them. Jesus' mission was to seek and save the lost...and then He transferred that mission to us by telling us to go and make disciples! (Luke 19:10; Matthew 28:18-20).
